## ORDER No. 128

## of the Rector of the Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń

### of 25 May 2021

### on the organisation of academic year 2021/2022

Pursuant to art. 23.1 of the act of 30 August 2018 Law on higher education and science (Dz.U. [Journal of Laws] of 2021, item 478 as amended) and § 12 of resolution no. 39 of NCU Senate of 30 April 2019 Rules of studies at the Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń (NCU Legal Bulletin of 2019, item 277)

### it is ordered as follows:

§ 1

1. The framework schedule of academic year 2021/2022 in the Toruń and Bydgoszcz campus of the Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń shall be as follows:

WINTER SEMESTER	1 October 2021 – 20 February 2022
Opening ceremony	1 October 2021
Classes	4 October 2021 – 22 December 2021
Winter break	23 December 2021 – 2 January 2022
Classes	3 January 2022 – 30 January 2022
Winter examination session	31 January 2022 – 13 February 2022
Retake winter examination session	14 February 2022 – 27 February 2022*
University Day	19 February 2022
SUMMER SEMESTER	21 February 2022 – 30 September 2022

Classes	21 February 2022 – 13 April 2022
Easter break	14 April 2022 – 19 April 2022
Classes	20 April 2022 – 14 June 2022
Summer examination session	15 June 2022 – 29 June 2022
Summer holidays	30 June 2022 – 30 September 2022
Retake summer examination session	1 September 2022 – 14 September 2022*

\*The final deadline for obtaining all credits and passing all examinations included in the plan of study is 28 February 2022 in the winter semester and 20 September 2022 in the summer semester.

- 2. In order for the classes to be carried out according to the plan of study, it is decided that:
  - 1) on 10 November 2021 (Wednesday) classes will take place as planned for Thursday;
  - 2) on 25 January 2022 (Tuesday) classes will take place as planned for Thursday;
  - 3) on 8 June 2022 (Wednesday) classes will take place as planned for Friday.

#### § 2

- 1. In accordance with the Act of 18 January 1951 on days free from work (Dz.U. Journal of Laws of 2020, item 1920), the following days are free from classes:
  - 1) 1 November 2021 (All Saints' Day),
  - 2) 11 November 2021 (National Independence Day),
  - 3) 6 January 2022 (Epiphany),
  - 4) 1 May 2022 (National Holiday),
  - 5) 3 May 2022 (The Constitution Day),
  - 6) 5 June 2022 (Pentecost),
  - 7) 16 June 2022 (Corpus Christi).
- 2. Additional days free from classes are as follows:
  - 1) 1 October 2021 (opening ceremony),
  - 2) 2 May 2022,
  - 3) 13-14 May 2022 (Student's Feast in Collegium Medicum),
  - 4) 20-21 May 2022 (Student's Feast in the Toruń campus).

#### § 3

- 1. Class schedules for full-time studies shall be determined by units managing those classes and then approved and announced by faculty deans in the USOS system or on faculty websites no later than 10 days before the beginning of a given semester.
- 2. Class schedules and meeting times for part-time studies shall be determined by units managing those classes and then approved and announced by faculty deans in the USOS system or on faculty websites no later than 10 days before the beginning of a given semester.

- 3. Any changes to class schedules and meeting times can be made only upon dean's approval.
- 4. The dean shall immediately inform students and teachers about any changes and updates to class schedules through the USOS system or faculty websites.

§4

Having consulted the faculty council of the student government, the dean of a given faculty may determine other examination session dates for students in their last semester of study, provided that the curriculum is fully completed.

§ 5 The order becomes effective as of 1 October 2021.
