ORDER No. 86

of the Rector of the Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń

of 2 April 2025

on the organisation of academic year 2025/2026

Pursuant to art. 23.1 of the act of 20 July 2018 Law on higher education and science (Dz.U. [Journal of Laws] of 2024, item 1571 as amended) and § 12 of resolution no. 39 of NCU Senate of 30 April 2019 Rules of Studies at the Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń (NCU Legal Bulletin of 2023, item 193)

it is ordered as follows:

§ 1

1. The framework schedule of academic year 2025/2026 in the Toruń and Bydgoszcz campus of the Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń shall be as follows:

2. In order for the classes to be carried out according to the plan of study, it is decided that:

- 1) on 7 January 2026 (Wednesday) classes will take place as planned for Monday;
- 2) on 8 January 2026 (Thursday) classes will take place as planned for Tuesday;
- 3) on 28 April 2026 (Tuesday) classes will take place as planned for Friday;
- 4) on 13 May 2026 (Wednesday) classes will take place as planned for Friday;
- 5) on 15 June 2026 (Monday) classes will take place as planned for Friday.

§ 2

- 1. In accordance with the Act of 18 January 1951 on days free from work (Dz.U. [Journal of Laws] of 2025, item 296), the following days are free from classes:
 - 1) 1 November 2025 (All Saints' Day),
 - 2) 11 November 2025 (National Independence Day),
 - 3) 6 January 2026 (Epiphany),
 - 4) 1 May 2026 (National Holiday),
 - 5) 3 May 2026 (The Constitution Day),
 - 6) 24 June 2026 (Pentecost),
 - 7) 4 June 2026 (Corpus Christi).
- 2. Additional days free from classes are as follows:
 - 1) 1 October 2025 (opening ceremony),
 - 2) 31 October 2025,
 - 3) 10 November 2025
 - 4) 7 April 2026
 - 5) 15 May 2026 (Student's Feast in Toruń),
 - 6) 22 May 2026 (Student's Feast in Bydgoszcz),
 - 7) 5 June 2026.

- 1. Class schedules for full-time studies shall be determined by units managing those classes and then approved and announced by faculty deans in the USOS system or on faculty websites no later than 10 days before the beginning of a given semester.
- 2. Class schedules and meeting times for part-time studies shall be determined by units managing those classes and then approved and announced by faculty deans in the USOS system or on faculty websites no later than 10 days before the beginning of a given semester.
- 3. Any changes to class schedules and meeting times can be made only upon dean's approval.
- 4. The dean shall immediately inform students and teachers about any changes and updates to class schedules through the USOS system or faculty websites.

§4

Having consulted the faculty council of the student government, the dean of a given faculty may determine other examination session dates for students in their last semester of study, provided that the curriculum is fully completed.

§ 5

In particularly justified cases, the rector, at the request of the dean and after consultation with the competent body of student self-government, may give permission for credits and examinations to be organised on a continuous basis in a given field of study.

§ 6 The order becomes effective as of 1 October 2025.
