1. The head of the examination commission checked the connection (availability) of all participants of the videoconference, i.e. checked whether the cameras and microphones of all participants of the examination were turned on. He/She asked the student to be visible and audible during the entire examination and to immediately report any technical problems, such as video or sound issues.
